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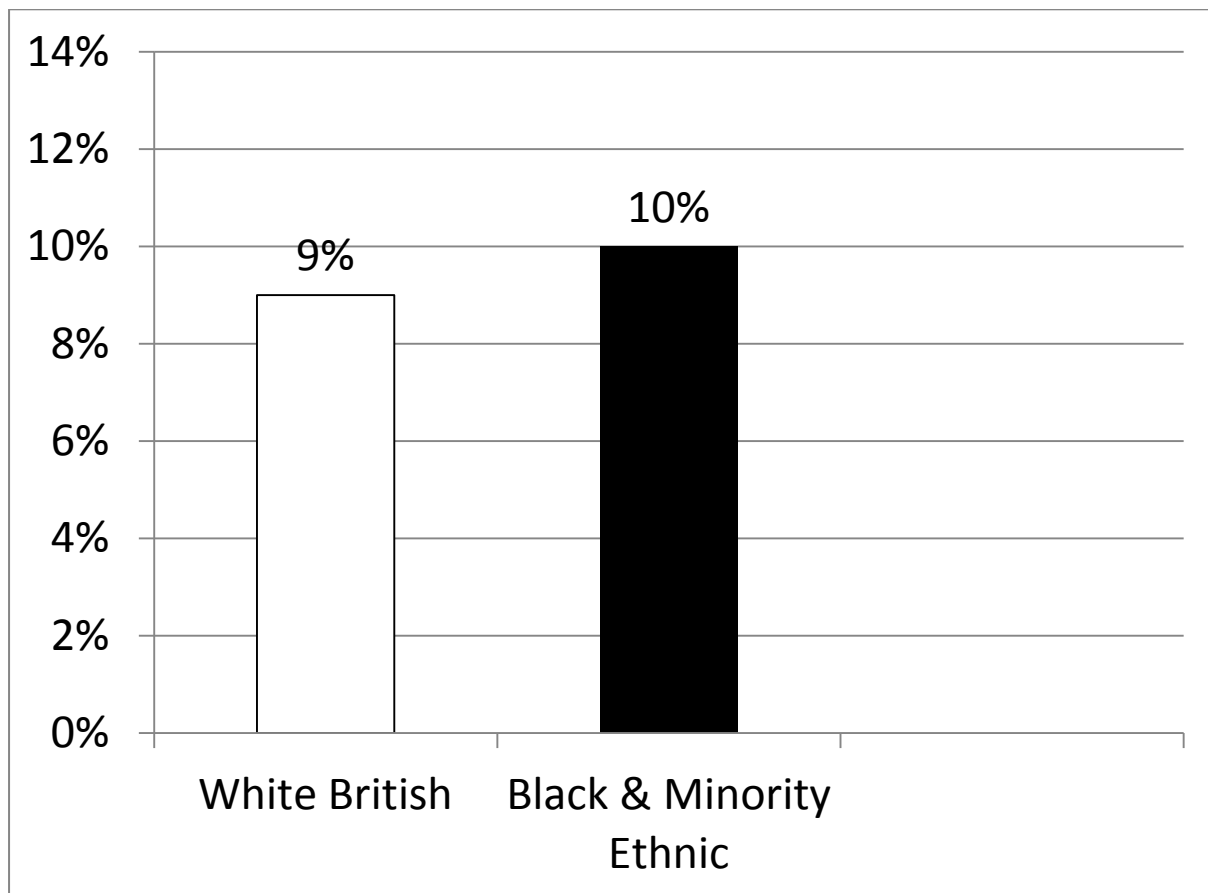
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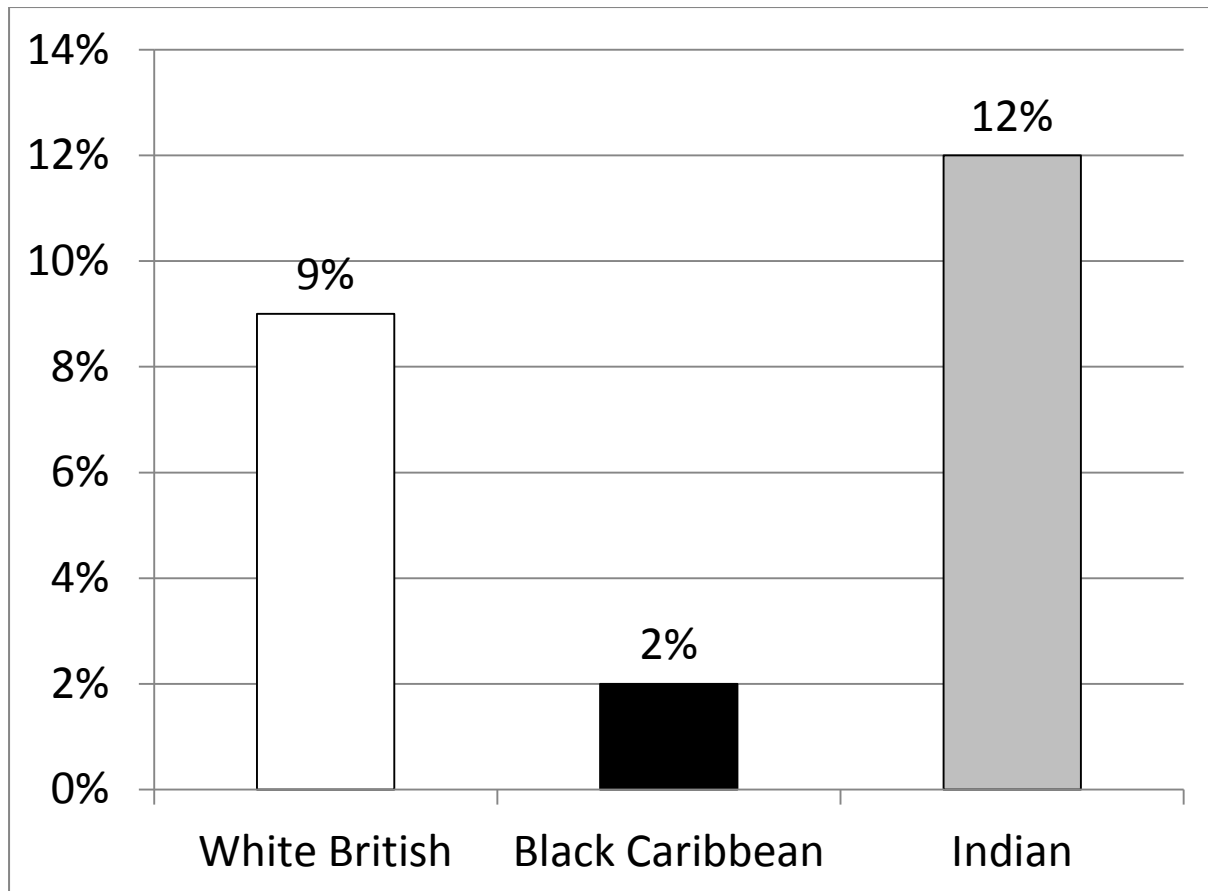
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Figure 1: Access to Elite UK (Russell Group) Universities: White and BME comparison
