Providing Examples: Hallam Graduate wins National Apprenticeship award



Holly Broadhurst was named the Higher or Degree Apprentice of the Year at the ceremony held in London.

Holly, 22, graduated from Sheffield Hallam last summer after completing a mechanical engineering top up degree following her higher apprenticeship at the JCB Academy. She is now a full-time design engineer for JCB.



Degree Apprenticeships and Social Mobility

Direct Learner contact with 39 Tier 1 schools from HEFCE target wards and 6 FE Colleges
Estimate a pool of 800 in total. Identify 160 pupils with potential to transition to degree
apprenticeships or those at level 4 with progression potential

Provide specialistadvice and support to 160 identified learners

Inspirational and tallored employer engagement activities

- Site to site vists.
- Employer/apprentice talks

Engage and source 140 employers looking to recruit higher and degree apprentices in 2018.

Deliver 6 learner preparation events and 3 Recruitment events, facilitating apprentice recruitment between learners and employers 'Review and adapt' activities



- Select sectors with significant employer demand/skill shortages.
- Don't underestimate the extent of employer engagement needed to get HDAs launched.
- Think about learner engagement, especially for open programmes and regional demand.
- Degree apprenticeships are different and therefore factor significant resource for staff engagement and development.
- Embrace change, be flexible and learn patience.
